

VALUATION DETAILS CHECKLIST



We hope this checklist document will help you identify what is required on your Valuation/receipt.

All valuations /receipts should be from a UK Jeweller or Independent Valuer and <u>must</u> be **less than 3 years old** and include the following:

Item(s) must be seen by the Jeweller at the time the valuation certificate is issued. Valuations / receipts must have the Jeweller's name, address and contact details.	
Signed and dated by the jeweller	
Your name or your partners name as proof of ownership	
Description of Item What the item is (i.e ring, pendant, bracelet, watch etc)	
Metal type (i.e platinum, white, yellow, rose gold, carat)	
Cut of diamonds/stones	
Carat weight of diamonds/stones	
Clarity of diamonds/stones (Required for items over £10,000)	
Colour of diamonds/stones (Required for items over £10,000)	
Basis of Replacement New Replacement Value or Second Hand Replacement Value	
In respect of watches	
Make, Model, Serial number	
Watch valuations must show the SHRV (second hand replacement value) or NRV (new replacement value) and be supported with a copy of the purchase receipt, photographs of the watch itself, watch box and warranty /guarantee card
